



## **The Anointing – Part 2**

**Gal 5:16-18 - I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. <sup>17</sup> For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. <sup>18</sup> But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.**

*What is the anointing? It is the power and knowledge of God put on the natural by God for super-natural accomplishments.*

*The anointing is our supernatural enabler. Enabler - A person or thing that makes something possible.*

*The anointing can reverse the results of the evil one.*

**Isa 10:27 - It shall come to pass in that day That his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, And his yoke from your neck, And the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.**

*Jesus was anointed by God with the Holy Spirit to do the work of the Father.*

**Acts 10:38 - how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.**

*Jesus Christ was anointed by God with the Holy Spirit to spread the Good News, do good things, and free those who have been held captive by the devil.*

*The anointing is a real spiritual tangible, a quantifiable source that rests on those whom God chooses. **2 Kings 13:20-21 - Then Elisha died, and they buried him. And the raiding bands from Moab invaded the land in the spring of the year. <sup>21</sup> So it was, as they were burying a man, that suddenly they spied a band of raiders; and they put the man in the tomb of Elisha; and when the man was let down and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived and stood on his feet.***

*You have an anointing to be a son and a servant of God if you said yes to Jesus being your Lord and Savior. **Gal 3:26 - For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. <sup>27</sup> For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.***

*Christ means the anointed one and the anointing.*

*When we were saved, we were baptized into the anointed one Christ and we put on the anointing.*

*The anointing flows upon everyone God chooses who says yes to the call.*

*The anointing is released by faith.*

*There is an anointing for every God-ordained walk of life.*

*Your anointing is primarily for others, not yourself.*

*David was chosen and the anointing flowed because he said yes to the call.*

*Once he accepted his assignment, the power flowed for him to be a Warrior, Priest and King.*

*The Anointing allows you to be who God says you are. **2 Cor 1:21 - Now He who establishes us with you (who confirms who we are) in Christ and has anointed us is God,***

*God calls us out so we can be smearred on. The anointing not only make the difference, but it makes you different.*

**2 Cor 6:17 - Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord.**

*There is also an anointing for you to be who you need to be according to your assignment. David-king, Joshua-leader.*

*God gives us a task or assignment according to who we are.*

*Sampson's primary gift was strength, and his assignment was to deliver Israel.*

**Judge 14:19 - Then the Spirit of the Lord came upon him mightily, and he went down to Ashkelon and killed thirty of their men.**

**Judge 14:6 - And the Spirit of the Lord came mightily upon him, and he tore the lion apart as one would have torn apart a young goat, though he had nothing in his hand.**

*Every Born-Again believer has a gift and assignment.*

*There is an anointing to use that gift and complete your assignment.*

*Sampson's anointing was for his strength. Yours may be something else.*

*Walking in the Spirit is walking in the anointing. **Gal 5:25 - If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.***
