



The "Armor of God" is a biblical metaphor found in Ephesians 6:10-18, it describes the spiritual tools that you as a Christian Youth can use to stand strong in your faith.



The Armor of God-Ephesians:6-10-18

- 10-In conclusion, be strong in the Lord [draw your strength from Him and be empowered through your union with Him] and in the power of His [boundless] might.
- 11-Put on the full armor of God [for His precepts are like the splendid armor of a heavily-armed soldier], so that you may be able to [successfully] stand up against all the schemes and the strategies and the deceits of the devil.
- 12-For our struggle is not against flesh and blood [contending only with physical opponents], but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this [present] darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) places.
- 13-Therefore, put on the complete armor of God, so that you will be able to [successfully] resist and stand your ground in the evil day [of danger], and having done everything [that the crisis demands], to stand firm [in your place, fully prepared, immovable, victorious].
- 14-So stand firm and hold your ground, HAVING [b]TIGHTENED THE WIDE BAND OF TRUTH (personal integrity, moral courage) AROUND YOUR WAIST and HAVING PUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS (an upright heart), 15-and having [c]strapped on YOUR FEET THE GOSPEL OF PEACE IN PREPARATION [to face the enemy with firm-footed stability and the readiness produced by the good news].
- 16-Above all, lift up the [protective] [d]shield of faith with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.
- 17-And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. 18-With all prayer and petition pray [with specific requests] at all times [on every occasion and in every season] in the Spirit, and with this in view, stay alert with all perseverance and petition [interceding in prayer] for all [e]God's people.



Armor of God:



Belt of Truth: Stay real and honest. This belt helps you stand firm in what you believe and live with integrity, even when it's tough.

Breastplate of Righteousness: Protect your heart by making good choices.
This armor reminds you to do what's right, even when it's hard.

Shoes of Peace: Be a peacemaker. These shoes help you bring calm and positivity wherever you go, especially in stressful situations.

Shield of Faith: Block out doubts and negativity. This shield is your trust in God, helping you stay strong when life gets challenging.

Helmet of Salvation: Protect your mind. This helmet reminds you that you're loved and saved by God, keeping your thoughts focused and positive.

Sword of the Spirit: Know your Bible. This sword is the Word of God, giving you wisdom and strength to make good decisions and stand up for your faith.

Prayer: Stay connected with God. Prayer is like the power source for your armor, helping you stay strong and grounded in your faith.
