God created mankind out of a deep desire for companionship and community, envisioning a family that would reflect His own nature in this physical realm of existence as it is in the Heavens.

The Bible speaks of at least two realms of reality. The Physical Realm and the Spiritual Realms.

Because of sin, this physical realm is a realm where things are temporal.

2 Corinthians 4:18 ...For the things which are seen are temporary.

2 Corinthians 4:18...but the things which are not seen are eternal. This is the spirit realm or a reality that is invisible.

Physical realm

This is the realm that consists of our everyday conscious existence and experiences. It encompasses the earth, sky, and atmosphere. It's where we live, work, and interact with the natural world.

Heavenly Realms - these consist of both Physical and Spiritual realms.

The Heavenly realms, biblically speaking, consist of the outer physical realm, which includes outer space, the sun, the moon, the stars, and the vast expanse beyond our atmosphere.

Psalms 19:1 The heavens proclaim the glory of God. The skies display his craftsmanship.

Two invisible Heavenly Realms that cannot be seen.

The lower invisible heavenly realm where fallen celestial bodies are located and confined. This is where most spiritual warfare occurs.

Ephesians 6:12-13 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

2 Kings 6:16-18 "Don't be afraid!" Elisha told him. "For there are more on our side than on theirs!" 17 Then Elisha prayed, "O Lord, open his eyes and let him see!" The Lord opened the young man's eyes, and when he looked up, he saw that the hillside around Elisha was filled with horses and chariots of fire.

The highest invisible heavenly realm is the spiritual realm, often described as the dwelling place of God, the spiritual sons of God, angels, and other heavenly beings abided in, but are not confined to.

This realm is where the throne of Almighty Father God resides.

Isaiah 66:1 This is what the Lord says: "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool.
