21 Day Faith Fast Confessions -Week One

Our tongue is an immensely powerful instrument. It can either manifest the blessings that Jesus won for us through his life, death, burial, and resurrection, or bring curses (failure) into our lives. The Bible says, **Proverbs 18:21 (NLT) The tongue can bring death or life; those who love to talk will reap the consequences.**

If there are areas in your life that need to change, your tongue is the best tool to bring about that transformation. In this time of consecration, let's pay particular attention to the words we use, choosing language that enhances the quality of our lives and those around us!

For 21 days in January, from the 5th to the 26th, we want every Jesus is Lord Assembly member to sacrifice by fasting and praying. By 8 pm each day, I will post the following day's confessions and scripture references on Facebook. Make the following confessions daily and expect the promises of God to manifest for God's Kingdom, our families, and our lives.

JLAL 21 Day Faith Fast Confessions Monday Day 1 January 5th- Confession for Ministry

I confess that Jesus is Lord ~ Assembly of Love (JLAL) is fulfilling a Godly Vision: To Save the Lost and Transform the Saved. This ministry will become more dedicated to helping spiritually lost individuals. JLAL will operate with greater integrity and favor, and it manages its affairs with discretion. As a kingdom ministry, JLAL is blessed by God to expand its outreach and overcome obstacles. All members and affiliates of JLAL experience blessings and favor because of our commitment to and connection with this ministry.

JLAL is more equipped with monetary and other resources necessary to fulfill God's purpose. JLAL church sees a daily increase in its membership, welcoming individuals from diverse backgrounds. The community within JLAL is committed to stewardship, faithfully managing the contributions made to the ministry, regardless of size. Every member who tithes or contributes to JLAL is linked to divine power and can expect a 100-fold return on their investment by faith.

JLAL 21 Day Faith Fast Confessions Tuesday, Day 2, January 6th- Confession-Family

A. God's favor causes my family to increase more and more **(Psalm 115:14).**

(For the Husband to say): My wife is blessed and highly favored among women **(Luke 1:28).**

She is a virtuous woman who prospers in everything she does at home, work, in business and in other affairs **(Proverbs 31:10-31).**

My relationship with my wife is good; together we have obtained the favor of the Lord **(Proverbs 18:22).**

B. **(For the Wife to say):** My husband is blessed and highly favored among men because God is with him **(Genesis 39:2; Luke 1:28).**

He sits in places of authority among other leaders **(Proverbs 31:23).**

C. **(Single Parent to say):** Even though I am a single parent, I have more of everything I need to raise my children in a godly way and oversee all my affairs with discretion and wisdom. **(James 1:5).**

Jesus Christ fills the void of not having a spouse in my home through the presence of the Holy Spirit and other Godly people He has placed in my life, just as He did for Hagar. **(Genesis 16:1-4)**

D. **(All Parents to say)**: My children are blessed and well-favored of God. They are skillful and wise, and they stand before kings **(Daniel 1:4-5, 9)**.

Like Jesus, my children increase in wisdom, stature and favor with God and men **(Luke 2:52; 1 Samuel 2:26; 16:22)**.

E. **(Singles with no Children)**: God is preparing the perfect mate for me, and when the Spirit of God causes our paths to cross, I have favor in his/her eyes. But until then, like the Apostle Paul, I will wait and serve the Lord with everything I have. And in doing so I will be well contented in the status of life I have now. **(Philippians 4:11-13)**.

Wednesday, Day 3, January 7th Confession-Protection

I confess that I am successful and strengthened in Christ, like a mountain; I will stand strong. Lord, you said that you have granted me long life and favor, and You will continue to do so. You have preserved my spirit, soul, and body from destruction. You are pleased with me, and Your favor lasts for a lifetime.

I declare that no matter what happens around me, I have a covenant of peace with You, God, and Your love, kindness, and favor will never depart from me. You surround and protect me with Your favor like a shield. Fear cannot rule my life because I have favor with You. My enemies, both seen and unseen, cannot triumph over me because You, have favored me. In Jesus name, Amen!

The Lord helps me guard the door of my mouth and teaches me not to speak against His favor at work in my life. I will not allow any corrupt communication to come out of my mouth. Instead, I will speak only about what is good, full of grace, and uplifting to others.

As the righteousness of God, I declare that I am favored in Your sight. Like Joseph, I prosper wherever I go and in every situation I face, because the Lord is always with me. I, too, experience preferential treatment from the Lord because I am chosen. Since association brings assimilation, I surround myself with those who are blessed and highly favored so that I may increase in every area of my life.

I operate with integrity; as a result, I receive favor from God. I actively seek and live by Your wisdom; therefore, I have great discretion and discernment as I navigate life, being esteemed highly in the sight of God and men. Like other godly men and women in the Bible, I declare that God's favor promotes me and causes me to increase daily.

The Father You takes pleasure in my prosperity in every area of life. I thank You, Father, that it is Your will for me to prosper spiritually, physically, financially, socially, and mentally. Because the favor of God protects me, no sickness or disease can dwell in my body. Wealth and riches are in my house because I am empowered by His anointing and favor to attract wealth.
